HISTORY AND HERITAGE

Vejle has a unique place in history. The Danish nation was born and created in Jelling very close to Vejle, when, King Harald Bluetooth had Denmark's name engraved on a runic stone in the tenth century.

Today the Jelling Monuments with the runic stones, the two large mounds, the church, the world's largest stone ship and an impressive palisade fence are among the

world's most significant monuments and included on UNESCO's World Heritage List.

In the visitor and experience centre, Kongernes Jelling, you can discover the exciting world of the Vikings and their monuments. The riders of the Tour de France 2022 even got a glimpse of our Viking history up close as they raced just beside the Jelling Monuments.

VEJLE WATERFRONT AND CITY CENTRE

In Vejle, modern architectural gems gleam alongside beautiful historic buildings. Renowned architects and artists, local as well as international, have made their mark on Vejle.

Not least along the waterfront, where over the past few years an exciting urban district has been created with recreational environments, award-winning architecture and sustainable housing. Here you find the iconic buildings Bølgen (the Wave) and Fjordenhus, designed by world-renowned artist Olafur Eliasson.

The 3rd stage of the Tour de France 2022 departed from the waterfront. The city centre also holds several noteworthy buildings. The eldest building in Vejle is the Sct. Nicolai Church from the mid-1200s, while Spinderihallerne,

Den Smidtske Gård (merchant house), Vejle Town Hall and the Vejle Windmill are all from the 1800s.

NATURE

Not far from the city, you will find some of Denmark's most scenic nature. From the rolling coastal woodlands to the meandering valleys of Grejsdalen and Vejle Ådal.

The lakes of Fårup Sø and Rørbæk Sø are scenically situated in the downs. You can cross this landscape along the Ancient Road from the river springs of Gudenåen and Skjern Å and the woods of Tinnet Krat to the moorland of Randbøl Hede.

You will also experience breath snapping bike rides along Denmark's toughest hill climbs as well as open countryside with inlet, lakes, heath, forest and meadows. There is room for families and proriders alike. You can also challenge yourself to the mountain bike trails.

Vejle gives para sports pride of place both through the big sporting events, but also in everyday life of the citizens, where the municipality has a strategic focus on bringing para sports into public sports and ensuring equal access to exercise for everyone.



FACTS ABOUT VEJLE

- Vejle is the ninth largest city in Denmark.
- The city of Vejle has approx. 60.000 citizens. Vejle municipality has approx. 115,000 citizens and the municipality is the fifth largest in Denmark.
- The location of Vejle in the middle of Denmark has created an international city with large international companies in the local area, such as Siemens and LEGO.
- Vejle is ranked as Denmark's Most Beautiful Shopping Town 2020-2022 and has previously been hailed as Denmark's Best, Denmark's friendliest and Denmark's most service-minded shopping town.

- The internationally acclaimed artist Olafur Eliasson have created Vejle's new iconic building, Fjordenhus, which is built in the harbour basin at Vejle Marina. Eliasson has also designed the exclusive Restaurant LYST at Fjordenhus, and the ground floor, which includes artworks by Eliasson, is open to the public.
- In Vejle, you will find Denmark's best cycling terrain and the toughest hill climbs. The toughest in all of Denmark is Chr. Winthersvej with a max. gradient of 25.5 % shortly followed by Gl. Kongevej with a max. gradient of 19.5 % and Kiddesvej with 19 %.
- Most museums in Vejle takes no entrance fee.

- The Jelling Stones are among the most significant monuments in the world and is included in the UNESCO World Heritage List. The Danish nation was born and created in Jelling.
- LEGOLAND Billund is Denmark's best known and loved entertainment park among families and children of all ages, who love action, speed and fun and is located just 30 minutes from Vejle.

SPORTING EVENT NATION AND DESTINATION

Previously, Denmark has hosted the IOC Session & Olympic Congress 2009 along with hundreds of World and European Championships within many different sports, including international para events.

Denmark has previously hosted – among other para events -the WWR (former IWRF) European Wheelchair Rugby Championship 2019 and the 2015 Para Table Tennis European Championships here in Vejle and the IWRF World Wheelchair Championships 2014 in Odense.

SPORT EVENT DENMARK THE NATIONAL SPORTING EVENT ORGANIZATION

Sport Event Denmark is the national Danish sporting event organization.

The organization is stablished and supported by the Danish Government.

The main objective of Sport Event Denmark is to help develop and promote sport, this involving the attraction and hosting of major international sporting events and congresses. Sport Event Denmark is primarily focused on sports that have a strong foundation within Denmark, either at the elite level or when it comes to sport for all levels.

DENMARK - THE LAND OF SPORTS CLUBS

Denmark has a unique tradition for associations in the world of sports.

- The main ingredient is the club volunteers: An estimated 550,000 volunteers hold the Danish associations together.
- Other resources primarily come from local businesses as sponsors, free facilities such as local schools and municipal support.
- The association phenomenon began in the 1860s with rifle associations as the first associations in Denmark.
- Approximately 11,000 sports clubs in Denmark.
- Approximately 1.65 million
 Danes are members of one or more organized sports clubs
 – that is without counting the members of commercial gyms.

Established in 1971, Parasport Denmark works to ensure that everyone can take part in sports, i.e., by initiating, supporting and qualifying new activities in sports associations and clubs across the country.

The federation, which also serves as the National Paralympic Committee, has strong partnerships with sports organizations, disability organizations and municipalities, all to increase sports activities and ensure their quality.

In addition, Parasport Danmark organizes a wide range of projects with the goal of introducing children and young people with disabilities to para sport, as well as fostering elite para-athletes and world-class role models.
